

ORIGAMI AND KIRIGAMI(PAPER CUTTING) WORKSHOP SYLLABUS

COURSE DESCRIPTION

This is a 2 1/2 hour workshop for any one who would enjoy learning to make both simple and more complex paperfolding forms(origami). It's great fun to see square sheet of paper transformed with few folds into a pretty flower or a lifelike animal. I will also introduce kirigami(papercutting) which is less folding, more cutting to create beautiful designs.

COURSE OBJECTIVE

The objective is do several types of simple kirigami and to make some relatively simple origami forms and put the to practical use as ornaments, display, to decorate stationery and greeting cards.

COURSE OUTLINE

- I. Hand out materials & instructions
- II. Kirigami: Demonstrate various type of papercuts and students practice them
- III. Origami: How to fold some of the following: (Items will vary according to specific themes) Examples are box, peacock, star, dolly angel, dove, heart, panda, etc.
- IV. Practical uses of the folded forms: as ornaments, displays, to decorate stationery and greeting cards

INFORMATION OF STUDENT INTEREST

Each student needs to bring a pencil, small scissors, and I will bring all other necessary materials—various sizes of origami papers, black cards, glue sticks, etc. and will need a material fee reimbursement of \$5 per student.
