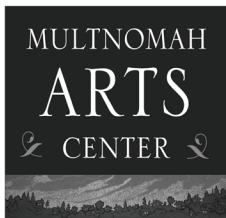
The Art of Beautiful Writing

Students need to bring to 1st class:

- Black ink (Pelikan Fount India)
- Nib (Brause 2-1/2 mm or Speedball C-2)
- * For left-handers: buy a left-handed nib
- Nib holder (try them out in your hand first)
- Roughly 5-10 sheets of 8-1/2 " x 11" paper
- Large pad of paper (17" x 22" Nekoosa)
- Pencil (and sharpener)
- Eraser (Staedtler Mars plastic)
- Black fine-tip felt pen
- T-square or metal ruler
- Apron or old shirt to protect your clothes
- Cotton rag
- Masking tape
- Notepad
- Small jar for rinsing pens

* **OPTIONAL:**

- *Text:* Written Letters by Jaqueline Svaren
- Watercolor paints and small brush
- Nice paper for final project (heavy watercolor, charcoal, etc.)
- Plastic sleeve (sheet protector) for hand-outs
- Smaller or larger nib sizes
- Artbox (tackle box) for carrying supplies
- Portfolio for carrying paper and T-square
- portable, lightweight drafting table (sloped tabletop)
