Any type of drawing paper and pencil will be fine for the first class. As many students are unfamiliar with options in art supplies we will discuss them during the first class. If you need to purchase basic supplies the list is as follows:

- 11" x 14" white bond paper sketchbook or 14" x 17" white bond paper sketchbook
- White plastic or pink pearl eraser
- 3B drawing pencil
- 6B drawing pencil
- Additional supplies that will prove useful:
- Small pencil sharpener that holds shavings
- Small packages of soft vine charcoal
- Kneaded eraser
- Blending stump
- Small brush to keep paper clean (soft paintbrushes work well)
- 8 B drawing pencil
- Tuff Stuff eraser stick and/or pencil point eraser
