

## Pen and Ink with Watercolor. Anji Grainger, Instructor summer 2017

### Materials list:

- Archival black ink pens - waterproof (very important)
- Archival Ink pens come in various sizes: .005, 1.0, 3.0, 5.0 for example. You can purchase a set for a great price at Dick Blick and other fine art stores
- One white gel pen. Here are some suggested brand names: Sakura Pigma Micron, Staedtler, Prismacolor, Faber Castell
- One full sheet of Arches 140 pound hot press or cold press paper (**not broken down-we will need a small portion of the full sheet to create the journal so it must be in it's full size of 30in long**). Hot press is smoother and will give more even lines however, I usually use cold press and it works just fine.
- One Small piece of 300 pound Arches watercolor paper (for the cover of your journal) - the size should be big enough to get two 4in x 6in pieces out of it.
- Your regular watercolor supplies - brushes, paints, pencil, eraser, etc.
- A board for taping down your paper
- Drafting tape - not masking tape, painters tape or blue tape. Dick Blick sells drafting tape at a great price.
- Paper Towels
