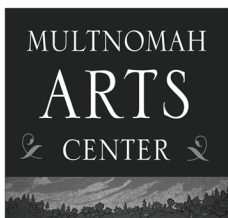

- White,
- Cadmium Red
- Alizarin Crimson
- Cadmium Yellow
- Hansa Yellow
- Yellow Ochre
- Raw Sienna
- Burnt Sienna
- Raw Umbre
- Burnt Umbre
- Cobalt Blue
- UltraMarine
- Viridian
- Black

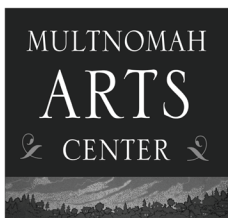
* Work with your budget. Student grade is the cheapest in price and quality, and is fine for beginners. I use Windsor Newton, Old Holland and Gamblin depending on color.

- **Mediums** Stand oil, made from lindseed oil.
- **Solvent** must be ODORLESS only (Gamsol is the best!) vegetable oil for cleaning brushes
- **Brushes** choose from round, bright and filbert styes, size range (biggest should be 1 1/2"), or buy a student set ALL WITH LONG HANDLES.
- **Canvas** canvas boards, canvas sheets (in a pad, bring clips) or prestretched
 - **Palette** 11" x 14" is a good size for masonite boards, glass or plexi, palette paper, plastic palette boxes (like tupperware container) are excellent.
 - **Palette Knives** metal are best, small and medium size
 - **Rags** skip paper towels-these work better!
 - **Cups** Brush cleaning cups, solvent & medium cups (empty tuna cans are perfect) -you must have one for clean solvent, dirty solvent & one for vegetable oil. Additionally, bring a jar with a lid for dirty solvent!
 - **Brush carriers** or roll ups that fold into stands (my preference.) or a can.
 - **Art box** For all above, traditional with space for palette or utility box style with palette in pallette container/box
 - **Smock**
 - **Brush Cleaning Soap** any type of gentle soap
 - **Sketch Pad, Pencil, Vine Charcoal & Eraser** for underdrawing on canvas

▼Acrylic Paint

- White,
- Cadmium Red
- Alizarin Crimson
- Cadmium Yellow
- Hansa Yellow Lt
- Yellow Ochre
- Raw Sienna
- Burnt Sienna
- Raw Umbre

- Cobalt Blue
- UltraMarine
- Viridian

* There are many brands to choose from. Work with your budget. Student grade is the cheapest in price and quality, and is fine for beginners. Utrecht or Golden brands are good.

- **Mediums** retardant (to slow drying time) AND a liquid gloss, semi gloss or matte
» *Optional: "Liquitex Soluvar" matt or gloss varnish for final protective coat*
- **Spray Bottle** for misting palette and painting (fine spray)
- **Brushes** choose from round, bright and filbert styes, size range (biggest should be 1 1/2"), or buy a student set ALL WITH LONG HANDLES.
- **Canvas, Canvas Boards, Canvas Sheets or Prestretched Canvas** 12" x 14 and up
- **Palette** 11" x 14" is a good size for masonite boards, glass or plexi, reg. or soakable palette paper, plastic palette boxes (like tupperware container) are excellent.
- **Palette Knives** metal are best, small and medium size
- **Rags** skip paper towels-these work better!
- **Cups** brush cleaning cups & medium
- **Brush carriers** or roll ups that fold into stands (my preference.) or a can.
- **Art box** For all above, traditional with space for palette or utility box style with palette in pallette container/box
- **Smock**
- **Brush Cleaning Soap** any type of gentle soap
- **Sketch Pad, Pencil & Eraser** for underdrawing on canvas
