PAINT: and may be purchased at your discretion.<br>Blue (Cobalt, or Ultramarine)<br>Reds (Cadmium Red Medium or Cadmium Red Light)<br>Alizarean Crimson<br>Yellow (Cadmium Yellow Light)<br>Yellow Ochre<br>Green (Viridian)<br>Burnt Umber<br>White (Titanium or Zinc)<br>Orange (Cadmium Orange)

Acrylic or Oil paint, tubes or jars. Note that paint consistency of jars is thinner than tube paint. It is a good idea to have at least the colors below (or similar). Additional colors are encouraged

## PAINTING MEDIUMS (optional):

For Acrylics: Polymer Medium, Gel, Gloss or Matte
For Oils: Linseed Oil

## PAINTING DILUTENT:

For Acrylics: use water;
For Oils: Odorless mineral spirits, Odorless terpenoid, citrus thinner)

## PAINTING IMPLEMENTS:

Brushes (sable and bristle; various sizes and shapes)
Palette knives - Metal, not plastic
Foam Brushes - assorted sizes

## PAINTING SURFACES:

Primer (Gesso)
Drawing paper
Canvas boards several (around 8" x 10")
Pre-stretched pre-primed canvas
Hardboard (such as Medium Density Fiberboard [MDF])

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MISCELLANEOUS:
Graphite or charcoal
Palette (glass or plexi glass is preferred)
Spray bottle
Water cans, jars or bottles
Painting clothes
Rags, sponges, paper towels
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
