HEALTH & SAFETY

Portland Parks & Recreation's primary goal is to keep our community healthy and to protect the public from the spread of COVID-19. PAY WHAT YOU CAN PRICING

It is thanks in large part to the Parks Local Option Levy ([Parks Levy](#)) that was approved by voters in November 2020 that we are in a position to be able to stabilize our community arts programming. The levy will raise approximately \$48 million per year for five years, providing crucial funding that will allow Portland Parks & Recreation to continue providing critical recreation services while centering racial equity and community partnerships.

With resources from the Parks Levy, we are also able to offer new payment options for City of Portland residents that allow you to choose payment levels based on your needs. We recognize that cost can be a barrier to participation. Using PP&R's Pay What You Can (PWYC) option, our registered classes can be reduced up to 75%. *No application is required.*

Ceramics - Intro to Ceramics

Ceramics is one of the most ancient, universally practiced, and beloved art forms around the world, dating back to 28,000 BCE. Designed for students new to the medium, this course will provide the beginner with a strong foundation in the cross-cultural and historical importance, contemporary practice, and techniques in ceramics from simple hand-built forms to basic forms thrown on the wheel.
