

Materials List for Art Wheel Class

There is a materials fee for this class which covers shared materials throughout this course (acrylic paint, etching cream, printmaking supplies, chalk, oil pastel, watercolor colored pencils etc....) In addition to the shared materials fee, you will need to bring basic materials for yourself.

Students should bring to class:

- **An assortment of brushes.** Cheap/value pack is fine. These will be used in watercolor, and acrylic projects. One of these brushes will be dedicated to glue/etching cream.
- **Palette.** This can be a plastic palette or clean plastic lids from food containers. We will use these to mix paint and hold ink.
- **Watercolor paint pad.** I recommend a watercolor paint pad, heavyweight, 140lb, around 9x12, with a minimum of 15 pages. (my personal favorite is Canson watercolor pad)
- **Watercolor Pan Set.** Crayola or inexpensive set will work just fine.
- **Ultra fine and fine tip Sharpie**
- **Scratch paper, pencil and eraser.** Used for sketching/idea work.
- **Assorted paper.** A few sheets of colored construction paper, scrap cardboard, newspapers etc... We will explore print making on different papers/surfaces, whatever you have/can find will be a fun experiment for this project. I will discuss this in more detail the week before the project.
- **Apron.** Many of the materials we will be experimenting with do not wash out of clothes. Dress for a mess.

The Following are optional:

- Drawing/mark making: colored sharpies, inks, pens etc... anything you might want to add to a painting. You may bring metallic paints or pens but please no loose glitter.
- Glass for etching. You will be provided with an upcycled piece of glass for our etching project. You may also bring in your own glass for this project (cup, vase, candle holder, etc...). Thrift stores are a great source for upcycling glass. You can also go to the \$1.25 store to purchase a glass item to etch. Students may etch up to three pieces of small glass. I will discuss this a week prior to the project.
- Acrylic Paint. You will be provided with basic primary acrylic colors for projects. If you would like more of an assortment, or specialty acrylics (metallic, etc...) you may bring them.

We will be watercolor painting on the first day of class so please make sure to bring your supplies. Also save your receipts in case you need to return or exchange items.
