Materials List for 3 day Tie Dye Workshop

There is a materials fee for this class which covers shared materials such as, various colors of dye, soda ash, resist, fabric, bleach, urea, handkerchiefs, etc... You need to bring the following to class:

- 100% Cotton White/off white t-shirt (new or used but must be 100% Cotton)
- Any other items you would like to dye: pillow case, extra shirt, etc... (must be 100% cotton)
- Dress in crummy clothes. There will be aprons provided but you really don't want to take any chances with nice clothing.

DAY 1-

MAC will give you 10 pieces of 100% cotton fabric scraps to practice 10 different resist methods.

Day 2-

You will rinse out your practice pieces from the previous day. Choosing your favorite designs/resists you will apply them to your shirt (or whatever you bring) and a provided handkerchief/tote bag from MAC.

Day 3-

You will rinse out your previous dyes and soak them in a solution that allows them to be washed in your washer machine (setting the dye). You will also have time to practice on 100% black cotton fabric and reverse bleach dying.
