WATERCOLOR brushes: recommended 1 each #10 and #12 round style

- 1 box, 24 count Nupastels
- 1 tube white gouache
- 1 glue stick
- 1 pair of scissors

1 roll masking tape (or other, for holding paper to you board)

A collection of paper scraps for collage (i.e. old drawings, labels, bags, wrapping paper, packaging, etc)

Watercolor Palette: A LARGE flat surface, plastic style palette, with edges.

Paper: 4 single sheets of watercolor paper 140 lb. cold press BEST BUY is STRATHMORE SINGLE SHEETS \$3 each at I'VE BEEN FRAMED/ ART SUPPLY SHOP, 4950 SE Foster Road, Ptld (the sheets are 22" x 30" each, ask the shop to cut them into quarter sheets for you)

Sketchpad no smaller than 11" x 14", you only need a few sheets

Drawing board, 16" x 20" is a good size to fit our format 1 or 2 drawing pencils,

A plastic wide-mouth water container,
