

WATERCOLOR MATERIALS LIST      INSTRUCTOR :  
CHAR FITZPATRICK      \*\*\*KEEP YOUR RECEIPTS\*\*\*

Tube watercolors: Black (any), Burnt Umber, Cadmium Yellow Light, Dioxazine Purple, Alizarin Crimson, Thalo Green (good brands: Cotman, Windsor Newton, Daniel Smith etc. \*\*avoid Blick's colors, not accurate)

Watercolor brushes: 1 each #10 and #12 round style

Watercolor Palette: A LARGE flat surface, plastic style palette, with edges

Paper: 4 single sheets of watercolor paper, 140 lb. cold press (22" x 30" each, cut into quarter sheets) BEST BUY: single sheets of Strathmore paper around \$3 a sheet @ I'VE BEEN FRAMED (Artist Supply Center) 4950 SE Foster Road, Portland. THEY WILL CUT YOUR PAPER INTO QUARTERS IF YOU ASK

Sketchpad no smaller than 11" x 14", you only need a few sheets

Drawing board, 16" x 20" is a good size, and fits our paper....

1 or 2 drawing pencils, masking tape
